The major in History consists of the following:

- **NINE courses** (TEN if writing a thesis, including HIST 493 and 494). **SIX** must be taken at Williams (**SEVEN** if writing a thesis); i.e., **THREE** courses may be taken abroad.
- **ONE Major Seminar** (HIST 301), preferably completed in the Junior year. If studying abroad as a Junior, students may enroll in HIST 301 in their sophomore year (space permitting) or in the Fall of their senior year. **HIST 301 can only be taken at Williams** (or WIOX - *Tacitus to Weber*).
- **ONE 400-level** Advanced Seminar or Advanced Tutorial. **400-Level courses must be taken at Williams.**
- A distribution requirement of **THREE** courses, one from each geographic group below (listed as **Groups A-G**)
- **ONE** course on the premodern period (**Group P**), which may be one of the courses used to fulfill the geographic requirement.
- [Note: cross-listed courses in History count for the major even without a HIST prefix.]
